- Critical care medicine research completed within the previous 12 months: This research may have previously been presented in abstract form or as a poster, but cannot be a published peerreviewed manuscript.
- Research in Progress and Case Reports will be accepted, but are not eligible for the Symposium Awards.

#### **Application Process**

• All application materials must be submitted online by midnight, August 22 2019.
